Kelly Grogg Discusses International Service

Kelly Grogg has served as Sunrise’s International Service Chair for the past three years. At the 8/19 meeting he described Sunrise’s recent efforts and plans for future activities.

Activities over the past three years have included:

- \$10,000 in donations to Polio Plus.
- Donation of 1,000 pair of shoes to Shoes for Orphan Souls
- Donation of two personal water wells.
- Participants in Alliance for Smiles mission trips.
- An investigative trip for the Honduras micro-loan project.

Ongoing efforts include: Shoes for Orphan Souls.

- We will deliver the shoes collected at the October District Conference in Rogers, AR.
- Our goal is to donate 700 pair of shoes and to beat out the Bixby and Claremore clubs.
- This year we want to expand the giving to the general public. We want to do this with publicity and collection sites at businesses, churches, etc.

Nicaraguan Water Wells

- This program was started by Bob Scroggs in the Downtown Club and has been underway for several years. Mickey Moore has been doing a lot of the drilling.
- The program is now affiliated with a new local club in Nicaragua. This club is located closer to the well sites.
