### Last week's program – Larry Biron

Larry spoke donating to the Rotary foundation and the importance of becoming a Paul Harris Fellow. When donating to the foundation 100% of the money raised goes towards the need as there are no administrative costs taken from the original donation. The foundation invests the donated money for 3 years and functions off of the profits. All the money donated 3 years ago (principle) goes towards the project.

Over the years Larry has personally seen the foundation make a big difference in projects around the world. He helped raise money through matching gifts that provided 386,000 diapers for South Africa. There is also a hospital that can mold prosthetic limbs thanks to an \$18,000 donation for a furnace.

These are just 2 of the many examples of the difference donating to Rotary can make on a local, district, & foundation level. So far this year \$50,000 has been raised for the Rotary foundation.
